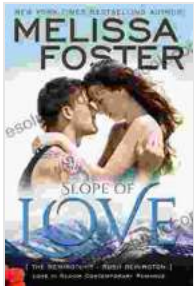

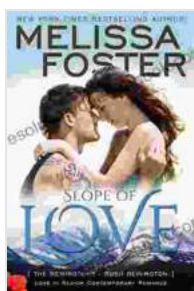
Music

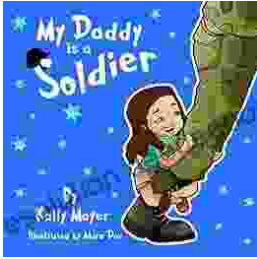

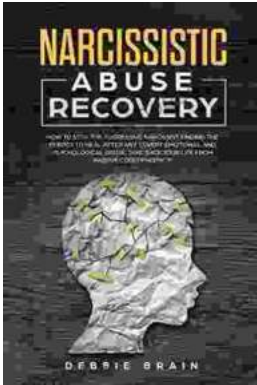
