Materials You'll Need

- 1 sheet of 14-count plastic canvas
- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn in orange
- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn in brown
- 1 skein of worsted weight yarn in cream
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Step-by-Step Instructions

1. Cut a piece of plastic canvas that is 10 squares wide by 6 squares high. Count 5 squares from the left edge and 3 squares from the bottom edge, and mark the center square. This will be the starting point for your design.
2. Thread your yarn needle with the orange yarn and bring the yarn up through the center square from the back of the canvas. Work a single crochet stitch in each of the next 4 squares to the right. Turn your work and single crochet back across the row.
3. Continue working in single crochet, alternating rows of orange and brown yarn until you have completed 12 rows.
4. Next, you will create the turkey's face. Thread your yarn needle with the cream yarn and bring the yarn up through the 5th square from the left edge and the 7th row from the bottom. Work a single crochet stitch in each of the next 3 squares to the right. Turn your work and single crochet back across the row.
5. Thread your yarn needle with the orange yarn and bring the yarn up through the 3rd square from the left edge and the 9th row from the bottom. Work a single crochet stitch in each of the next 3 squares to the right. Turn your work and single crochet back across the row.
6. Thread your yarn needle with the cream yarn and bring the yarn up through the 3rd square from the left edge and the 11th row from the bottom. Work a single crochet stitch in each of the next 3 squares to the right. Turn your work and single crochet back across the row.
7. To finish the turkey's face, embroider two black dots for the eyes and a small red triangle for the beak.

8. To create the turkey's feathers, thread your yarn needle with the orange yarn and bring the yarn up through the 9th square from the left edge and the 4th row from the bottom. Work a single crochet stitch in each of the next 3 squares to the right. Turn your work and single crochet back across the row.
9. Continue working in single crochet, alternating rows of orange and brown yarn until you have completed 12 rows.
10. To finish the tissue box cover, cut the excess yarn and weave in any loose ends. Place the tissue box cover over a standard-size tissue box and enjoy your festive Thanksgiving decoration!

Tips

- If you are new to plastic canvas, be sure to practice your stitches on a small piece of scrap canvas before starting your project.
- Use a yarn needle that is the correct size for the yarn you are using. A too-small needle will be difficult to thread, and a too-large needle will create holes in your canvas.
- Be patient and take your time. Plastic canvas can be a bit tricky to work with, but the results are worth it.

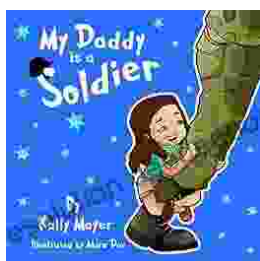
